

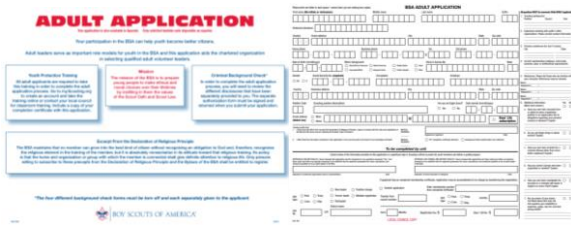


# Basic Leadership Pathway for Scout Leaders

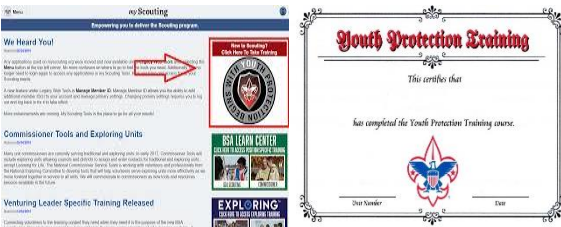
You've just been invited to "sign up" as a new Scouting leader and you are not sure what you need to do. FIRST, "THANK YOU" FOR CONSIDERING SCOUTING LEADERSHIP! The opportunity to help shape the lives of young people is a great privilege and responsibility. It is not to be taken lightly! Of course, you want to do a good job, so, what do you need to do?

## Step One: The Application

Initially, you will be asked to complete a BSA Adult Leader Application (be sure to use the CURRENT form):



You will be asked to complete Youth Protection Training (YPT), either online at [my.scouting.org](http://my.scouting.org) where you will need to set up an account unless you already have one (*please be sure and write down your username and password!*).



Or, you may be able to complete the training in person with a certified YPT Trainer in your District.

Upon completion, you should print and attach your YPT completion certificate to your BSA application and return them both to the unit you are joining.

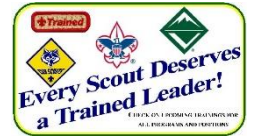
## Step Two: Training

You are not being asked to undertake leadership without support. The BSA adult training program is thorough and well-respected. Avail yourself of it... don't delay in completing your "Basic Training" for your position as soon as possible!

The required training depends on the position you are undertaking.

**ALL POSITIONS** have complete online training at [my.scouting.org](http://my.scouting.org)

**with the exception of "The Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills" course required for all leader positions in Scouts BSA.** This course is offered "in person" by the Council and District Training Committees. **Please notify the District Training Chair of your registration so "in person" training may be scheduled, if required.** Your District Training Chair is:



## Step Three: Enjoy!

Scouting is fun for adults, as well as young people! Engage yourself with the special camaraderie and service opportunities of Scouting. Beyond your unit's regular meetings and activities, there are monthly "Roundtables" held by the Districts to facilitate the sharing of best practices, upcoming information about the Scouting program, and to help you develop Scouting friendships.

## Step Four: Grow!

Your full enjoyment of Scouting as a leader is in direct relationship to your on-going training. Self-development and training opportunities abound in Scouting. University of Scouting events, Pow-Wows, special events, and more are held by the Council to help you grow as a leader. Once you have completed the "basics" you will be ready to hone your skills as a leader with more "advanced" offerings. There are numerous specialized trainings available to help further your ability to offer effective leadership. Ask your Training Chair about them!
